

Daily Cleaning Checklist: Conveyor Dishwashers

How to Keep Your Equipment in Top Shape

1. Turn Off the Machine



Push the “power” button to turn the machine off. Disconnect the electrical power to the machine before beginning cleaning.

2. Lift Drain Lever



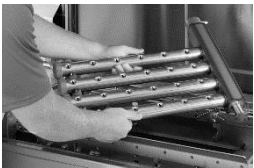
Open the drains by lifting up the drain lever that is inside the door opening.

3. Remove & Clean Curtains



Remove the curtains and clean in a mild detergent. Leave out to fully dry.

4. Remove & Clear Wash Arms



Remove the wash arms and end caps. Flush in a sink and check for any obstructions.

5. Remove & Clean Strainer & Scrap Basket



Remove the strainer and the scrap basket. Move to a sink to scrub.

6. Clean Standpipe & Pump Intake Screen



Remove the standpipe and pump intake screen to clean in a sink.

7. Spray Interior



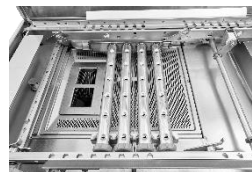
Flush interior of the machine with a hose to clear debris.

8. Wipe Down Exterior



Wipe down exterior of the machine with a wet washcloth. Do not spray the exterior with a hose.

9. Reassemble All Parts



Return all components that were previously removed.

10. Leave Doors Open



Leave the doors open to air out the machine and dry overnight.
